



Preparing Universities to Cooperate with Neuroatypical Students: Second Partners' Meeting in Riga, Latvia



The second transnational meeting of the Erasmus+ project took place on 15–16 September 2025 at Riga Technical University in Riga, Latvia.

Partners reviewed overall progress and discussed the next implementation steps. A key focus was the presentation of primary research conducted by each institution, including interviews with university administrators, student surveys, and focus groups with academic staff. These insights offered a comprehensive understanding of current practices and challenges in supporting neuroatypical students.

The consortium also worked collaboratively on developing the project's guide — a core output designed to provide practical strategies and tools for fostering inclusive higher education environments. In parallel, partners outlined dissemination strategies to effectively share project results across Europe through academic, institutional, and digital channels.

The meeting concluded with agreement on the upcoming timeline, including drafting and reviewing the guide and preparing future workshops.
